N ineteen-year-old, first-time mom, Tina, was expecting. She qualified for the Nurse-Family Partnership program, funded by the United Way.

As part of the program, a registered nurse visited her bi-weekly, from 28 weeks before birth until the child was 2 years old.



Since enrolling in the program for first-time, income-eligible moms, Tina has married the child's father, and has decided to further her education.

The nurse not only provided physical screenings for mom and child, but also helped Tina map a plan for her to achieve her goals. This spring she will graduate from college.
